THE JOHN TANTON NETWORK AND THE ANTI-IMMIGRANT MOVEMENT IN AMERICA

“I have all along seen the immigration battle as really a skirmish in a wider war . . .”

John Tanton, founder of U.S. Inc. and the Federation for American Immigration Reform (FAIR)

Michigan ophthalmologist John Tanton seeded the contemporary anti-immigrant movement in the United States in 1979 when he launched the Federation for American Immigration Reform (FAIR), and in 1982 with his formation of U.S. Inc. While little-known to the general public, FAIR and U.S. Inc. are the heart of one of the oldest and most influential anti-immigrant networks in the country. Both are the progenitors to many of the national anti-immigrant groups active today. Additionally, Tanton’s U.S. Inc. serves as the primary fundraising vehicle for this contemporary anti-immigrant network.

What appears to the public and the media as a myriad of voices advocating for draconian immigration enforcement is nothing more than a series of front groups, “coalitions,” and spin-offs seeking to overwhelm any rational debate on immigration. The Center for Immigration Studies, founded by Tanton in 1985, serves as a pseudo-think tank to the anti-immigrant movement. The Coalition for the Future American Worker pretends to be the voice of American workers. The truth is much simpler: it is one network and one message – “a temporary moratorium on all immigration except spouses and minor children of U.S. citizens and a limited number of refugees.”

Early funding from the notorious Pioneer Fund (committed to eugenics and “scientific racism”) enabled the Tanton network to expand to a multi-million dollar operation. Respected civil rights organizations around the country—including the Southern Poverty Law Center and the Anti-Defamation League—have raised public concerns regarding the Tanton network’s relationship to political extremists, including hate groups. The Tanton network’s ties to white supremacists associated with the Council of Conservative Citizens and to the VDARE Foundation serve only to heighten growing unease about it within the civil rights community.

The Center for New Community is distributing the Tanton Network Map as a tool for journalists. Journalists have a duty to label the Tanton network and the many anti-immigrant organizations it has engendered for what it is – controversial. Producing a series of front groups and spin-offs is not an acceptable barrier to informed and ethical reporting on immigration. As the nation once again begins debate on immigration reform in the United States, the public turns to the media for informed facts and opinions. Media coverage of those speaking on behalf of groups within the Tanton network should be adequately and appropriately identified.
